Hello, I'm Aurélie, an eco-fashion workshop provider passionate about helping children explore creativity through sustainability. I design hands-on sessions where pupils learn to upcycle, repair and reimagine clothing in fun and accessible ways.

# School Workshops

These workshops are aligned with STEAM learning and designed for Reception to KS2, combining creativity, design thinking, practical mending skills, and environmental awareness in an engaging, age-appropriate way.

Students don't just make something, they build confidence, problem-solving skills, and a deeper understanding of how caring for clothes can reduce waste.





# Key Stage 1

## Early Years Workshops (Reception and KS1)

These Early Years workshops are tailored for younger children, using short, interactive sessions designed to suit their developmental stage and concentration levels.

Activities encourage creativity, confidence, and fine motor skill development while introducing simple sewing and textile techniques through playful, hands-on learning.

### Workshop Structure (Approx. 40 mins)

- Introduction to textiles and sewing using storytelling, demonstrations, and visual prompts
- Guided practical activity such as threading, fabric exploration, or beginner stitching
- Sensory, tactile, and age-appropriate learning activities
- Optional take-home creation for children to continue exploring at home

### Group Size

Up to 20–24 children (depending on age and support staff)

Multiple sessions can be booked back-to-back for larger groups or full-day programs.



# Key Stage 2

## School Workshops (KS2)

Children are introduced to practical sewing and textile techniques while learning how materials can be repaired, reused, and redesigned instead of thrown away.

Sessions encourage creativity, experimentation, and independent thinking, while naturally supporting areas of the primary curriculum including Art & Design, DT, Maths & PSHE.

### Workshop Structure (Approx. 90 mins)

- Quiz - intro to textile sustainability
- Introduction to sewing (threading a needle, simple hand-stitching)
- Guided, hands-on stitching activity tailored by year group (finished project to take home)
- A “mending mission” card for each student

### Group Size

Up to 20–24 children (depending on age and support staff)

Multiple sessions can be booked back-to-back for larger groups or full-day programs.
